Once you have downloaded the Skool Loop App, via either your Google Play or App store, please follow the below instructions to select your school -

- Click the 'Select your schools' this will bring you to a menu you can either search your school or follow the country/region prompts.
- Once you reach your school, select it with the tick on the righthand side
- Tap the 'select schools' button in the top right corne
- Tap the big orange choose button. This will load your school and bring you to the settings page

Secondary (please note) **Learning Recognition Credits**

To recognise lost learning this year NZQA have again provided Learning Recognition Credits (LRC). These credits have no 'level' attached to them and will be applied in January when external results are released.

Our students do not currently qualify for any endorsement or University Entrance changes.

In 2021 Level 1 students qualify for 1 LRC per 5 credits, up to a cap of 8 (require 72 credits for NCEA L1). Level 2 and 3 students have a cap of 6 (require 54 credits for NCEA L2/3).

There are no changes to the Numeracy and Literacy credits required.






