Dear Parents / Caregivers

Kia ora koutou

As Term 2 comes to a close we are busy with enrolments, drama presentations, the 40 Hour Famine, Matariki activities and weekly interschool sports along with the Area Schools Tournament in Whangarei. School activities both inside and outside the classroom are back to our pre Covid 'normal'.

We have received delivery of air purifiers which we have deployed into the Library, Church and classrooms to further protect students and staff.

Chris French and I will be attending a Canterbury Christian School meeting next month to help plan the Parent Health & Sexuality Consultation Survey we are working on together with all Canterbury Christian schools. We will deliver this year the Survey to gather a Canterbury-wide voice of Christian parents on the new Health Curriculum and discuss this at meetings with you later this year. Our programmes for 2022 will remain unchanged while we work on this.

The position requires you to complete several administrative tasks to plan and prepare for the exams from August to October. 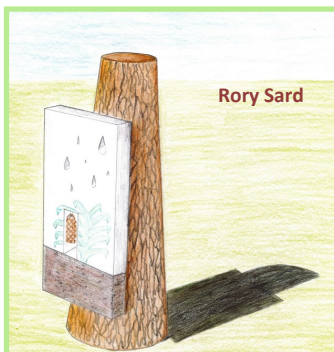

Their sign was to:

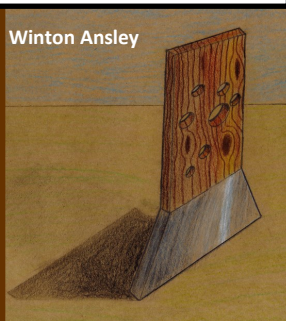
- have a location (inside or outside).
