Dear Parents / Caregivers

Tena Koutou... A big thank you to our community in completing our BOT Strategic Plan Survey. We had 240 responses from parents, students and teachers. The response affirmed the strategic directions the BOT sought feedback on. In looking at the wider areas, I am pleased to report 10 areas of strength that the survey identified.

1. Use of digital devices.
- 2 The school being a safe place.
3. Leadership is strong.
4. Expectation for learning is high.
5. Partnership between parents, students and teaching.
6. Students receive timely feedback.
7. School has high quality teaching.
8. School promotes lifelong learning habits.
9. Classrooms are pleasant learning environments.
10. School supports those with special needs.

Areas highlighted that the community felt could do better:

1. Visibility of Māori culture and customs.
2. Range of subject options.
3. School communications.

We will further engage with our parents and students to unpack and improve our performance in these areas. What was clear from the feedback from all stakeholders was the clear message that the most important strategic direction for the school is "Keep Christ at the centre of everything we do".

On a different note we welcome Lois Fordyce as our new Receptionist, who joined our Team on September. Glenda is now the Principal's PA and Admin Services Manager.

A morning tea was given by some of the Parents of our school, for which we are extremely grateful and thankful for.

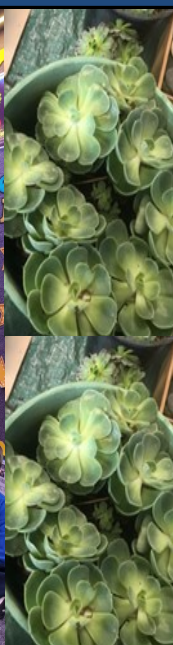

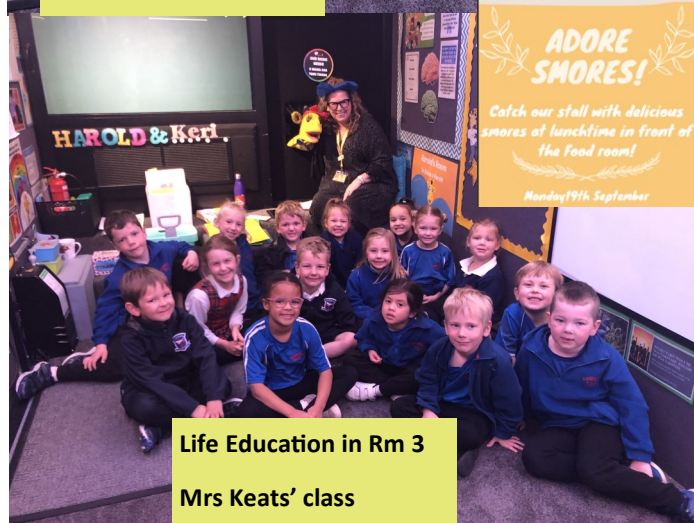
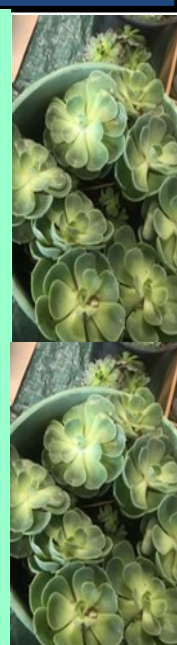

Do you like sherbert who is not lucky for anyone who is a fan of the delicious powdery treat - the Sherbert Shack can provide you with as much as you want.

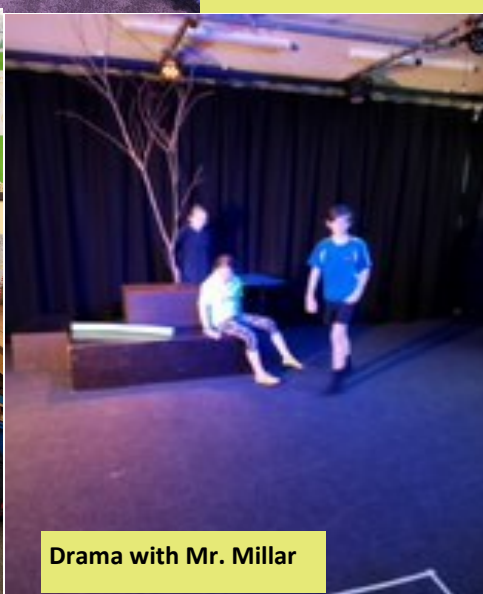
