We keep a register of students and staff allergies, which include allergies to foods, bee stings and other medical conditions. One of our new teachers at RNLS—Susan Kingsley, has given permission to share her very sensitive allergy to peanuts. In her school last year, she had an anaphylactic reaction to peanuts. Her sensitivity to peanuts is severe even to people who have eaten peanuts in the last 20 minutes. The peanuts cause her a severe allergic reaction. In consideration of her and a number of other students within the school with this sensitivity, I would ask that you be mindful of this when you pack student lunch boxes. As a teacher, Susan works in Secondary, although she does interact with all students at intervals and lunch times. We have been advised that the PPTA has called a strike on 16th March. As virtually all our secondary teachers are PPTA members, our school will be closed for SECODNARY students only on this day. Primary students and school We are still looking for billets for CASAfest, see the note in the newsletter.

Our students have a regular prayer meeting each week. Our staff pray in their devotion 3 times a week. Gateway Church has a regular prayer session every Friday. We also have a parent prayer time every Monday at 9 am, in the Church. I invite new parents and existing ones to this prayer time for the school, students and wider community. I hope to see you there, on Monday, where I will be buying coffees.

This week we remember the 12th anniversary of the Christchurch earthquake. At that time, Hastings Christian School connected with our school and community. At this time, we plan to reciprocate with their community as they recover from the floods. We will have a non-uniform day next week Friday; our students will write cards with messages. Our PTA last night donated a sum of money to their PTA. We pray for the victims of the flooding.
