Dear Parents / Caregivers Kia ora koutou

Thank you to those families who have offered billets for CASAfest. We are looking forward to 'our turn' in hosting CASAfest, a privilege that comes around every 7 years.

Also a thank you to the PTA for the lunch scheme they are running.

At this time I would like to express my appreciation to our teachers at RNLS. At various times of the year I report student achievement progress. The excellent results that we report are as a result of the high quality teaching and learning that our staff do. Not all schools are as blessed with teachers that are so dedicated — we know that our reading, writing and mathematics results are always in the high 80% to 90% achievement, well above the national and local comparisons. For NCEA our results show a high pass rate, in many cases 20% higher than national and local averages. For example, 89% of our L1 students passed NCEA last year. The national and prevailing local average in other schools was 65—80%.

I am very proud at the dedication and hard work our teaching and support staff, who work individually with all our Tamariki. I feel they deserve this recognition and acknowledgement. Our school was formed over 40 years to provide a Christian education for North Canterbury families. I am proud our staff, not only provide high quality Christian education, but the highest quality academic education from Y1 to Y13.

EVERY CHILD READY TO LEARN

NORTH CANTERBURY CHILDREN NEED HELP. PLEASE SUPPORT AND BUY BULBS.

Many North Canterbury primary school children are struggling to succeed at school. The struggles being faced by students, families, teachers, and schools have been highlighted in recent reports from many of the 41 primary schools in our area. Rangiora Rotary Club wants to assist to ensure that every child gets the best chance to use the education offered so they can grow to be the best they can be, and a fully contributing member of our community.

The Rangiora Rotary Club has created a "Ready to Learn" fund. We want every student to start school with an equal chance and be "ready to learn". We want every student to have the opportunity to attend school with uniforms, footwear, and stationery. We want every student to have access to school activities, specialist support, and school sport, without the cost being a barrier.

The "Ready to Learn" fund is intended to assist financially disadvantaged children and is available to be distributed between all North Canterbury primary schools. It is co-administered by the Rangiora Rotary Club and the North Canterbury Principals' Group. This year all proceeds from our annual bulb sale will support this fund.

How can you help?

2023 sees us continue both with the stall outside New World Rangiora and online. Bulb sales of daffodils, freesias, snowflakes and bluebells. These make excellent gifts for birthdays or Easter and will brighten up any plant pot or garden in Spring.

- Freesias x 15 per packet (Bulbs NZ)
- Bluebells x 10 per packet (Hadstock Nursery)
- Snowflakes x 10 per packet (Hadstock Nursery)

All packets cost \$10 and bulbs should be planted before the end of May.




