Casafest by the numbers...

168 Students from 6 Area Schools (including RNLS). 82 Students billeted by our community. 24 Rounds of activity including volleyball, ripper rugby, trampolining, lawn bowls, cross fit, art challenge, triangle ball, gaga dodge ball, four square, master chef challenge, basketball, theatre sports, board games, back yard cricket, hand ball, paddle boarding, athletics pentatholon, technology challenge, bouldering, top school challenge, korfball, turbo touch rugby, tchock ball.

There were over 200 dinners supplied on Monday, servings of butter chicken, vege korma, servings of spaghetti bolognese, and servings of sweet and sour chicken. We had 5 food trucks for the social evening.

Many hundreds of kilometers were travelled from Akaroa, Amuri, Hurunui, Cheviot, and Oxford Area Schools.

Each event generated points, which were won by the teams. The overall winner of the 24 rounds of challenges was Oxford. The far play award went to Hurunui Area School.

There were approx. 41 helpers from our school, and approx. 17 helpers outside our school. There are so many people that contributed to the success and I thank everyone for their contributions.

Well done to our RNLS team, who were second overall in both fair plan and points overall.

- **Rear-Facing is Safest** It's safest for all infants and toddlers to ride in a rear-facing car seat as long as possible.
- **Wiggle Room** Once a car restraint has been isntalled it shouldn't wiggle (or move) more than 2.5cm in any direction.
- The Pinch Test You can check your child's harness straps are tight enough by using the pinch test (find out more by watching our video or viewing our toolkit below)
- **Harness Height** You should aim to have the harness of your child restraint in line with the top of your child's shoulders. But remember to always check your manufacturer's instructions
- 148cm It's much safer for children to remain in a booster seat until they're 148cm tall regardless of their age. As a reference, many children won't reach this height until they're about 12 years of age.


