<u>Lab Visits</u>: Mrs Abelen-Freeman (Head of Science) ran two science lab sessions with our classes in Week 1. The first session covered an introduction to the lab, the Bunsen Burner and a simple experiment (burning magnesium). The second session conducted a more complex fair test experiment. The hypothesis was, 'adding salt to water makes the water boil faster'. Such visits with high school specialist staff and the use of facilities are a real strength in our school and create wonderful learning opportunities for our primary students.

Rangiora New Life is seeking an Examination Centre Manager to run the NCEA and NZ Scholarship examinations in 2023. The position requires you to complete a number of administrative tasks to plan and prepare for the exams. My name is Charlotte Christie and I am a mum to a wonderful 14 year-old boy who attends a public high school.

As we are all aware, and what has been seen on recent news, children as young as 6 are accessing vaping products and using them on school premises and within our community.

According to statistics from a recent Asthma Foundation survey, 20% of students are now regular users of such products and they are mostly accessed from local dairies and convenience stores. This is an alarming number of young people exposing themselves to potentially harmful toxins and chemicals with effects not yet known.

These products often appear to be the target for the extremely staggering amount of ram raids and crime that is being committed by some of the young members of our community.

I have started two petitions to remove the sale of vaping products from dairies and convenience stores which I implore you to share with your faculty and school community.

If you could, please allow them to be featured in your next newsletter so parents and caregivers can have a say and we can rally together as a community to put a stop to the negative behavior and severe health effects that has been and continue to be prevalent in our school system and societies.


